Championship Regulations General



1.1. TITLE. Shenington Kart Racing Club - 2016 Club Championship

1.2. JURISDICTION. The series is organised and administered by the Shenington Kart Racing Club (SKRC) in accordance with the General Regulations of the Royal Automobile Club Motor Sports Association (MSA), (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and the MSA specific regulations for karting, where applicable, the ABkC regulations within the 2016 MSA Kart Race Yearbook and these Championship regulations. MSA Championship Permit No: CHK2016/K058; Status: Clubman. GRADE: D Un-sponsored (non-commercial).

1.3. OFFICIALS.

1.3.1. The Co-ordinator: Mrs. S. Game.

1.3.2. Eligibility Scrutineer: Mr. P. Klaassen.

1.3.3. Championship Stewards: Any 3 of the following: Mrs. Joan Smith, Mr. Boyd Barrington, Mrs. Julie Dredge, Mr. Mark Riman

1.4. COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY: Entrants must be fully paid up valid membership card holding members of SKRC and in possession of a valid 2016 MSA Entrants licence. Competitors under the age of 18 must be accompanied by the holder of a Kart PG Entrant's licence who must sign on as Entrant of that competitor. Drivers and Entrant/Drivers must be fully paid up valid membership card holding members of SKRC, and must be in possession of a valid MSA National "B" (Novice) Kart licence (minimum) or valid Licence and Medical issued by Motorsport Ireland (H26.1.1 & H26.1.5), or be a professional driver in possession of a valid licence (featuring an E.U. flag) and medical, issued by the ASN of a member country of the European Union.

1.4.1. A competitor shall not take time off school to participate in motor sport without the prior written approval of their school. If participation in the Championship requires absence from school, drivers in full time school education are required to have the approval of their head teacher and a letter stating such approval from his/her school in order to fulfil registration for the Championship.

1.4.2. All necessary documentation must be presented for checking at all rounds when signing on.

1.5. REGISTRATION. All racing members of Shenington Kart Racing Club are automatically registered for the Club Championship.

1.6. CHAMPIONSHIP ROUNDS. Direct Drive Championships will be contested over 12 rounds, all at Shenington Circuit, all organised by Shenington Kart Racing Club on the following 2016 dates: 17 January, 21 February, 20 March, 17 April, 15 May, 19 June, 16/17 July, 21 August, 18 September, 16 October, 30 October and 20 November. Should a meeting have to be cancelled by force majeure, subject to the approval of the MSA, a championship bulletin will be issued and a replacement date will be promulgated from either 29 May or 31 July or another. A minimum of three weeks notice will be given.

1.7. SCORING FOR CHAMPIONSHIPS.

1.7.1. Points will be awarded as follows, but only if there are 5 or more drivers racing at that round: A Final 1st place 56, 2nd place 52, 3rd place 50, 4th place 49 reducing by 1 point in 1 place increments including the B Final down to the position which would gain 10 points but ignoring the first four in the B Final. No points are awarded in C or D finals. No points are awarded in novice-only races. No points are awarded for a non-start, except for the A Final when a B Final has been held. If qualifying classes are mixed within the same race starting together, points are awarded for the class finishing position.

1.7.2. The final Championship positions will be determined from the totals of a maximum of 9 best scores from all 12 rounds, unless for some reason meetings are cancelled and not replaced, or where there have been insufficient entries to award points, in which case the number of Championship rounds to count will be 2 less than the total number of Championship meetings or rounds actually held or where numbers were insufficient.

1.7.3. Should any driver or kart be excluded from the meeting for any reason they cannot drop that round, it will count as one of their counting rounds. MSA general regulation C3.5.1 will apply with the exception of penalty (C) which will not apply. The minimum action resulting from infringement of technical regulations arising from post race scrutineering or Judicial Action will be exclusion from the race or timed qualifying session, and the maximum action will be exclusion from the meeting, except that this will not be applied in the case of drivers/karts being underweight, or in the case of a technical infringement due to an incident during the race, such as an Air Box falling off etc. The penalty for these types of infringements, which will be at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course, shall be exclusion from the race.

1.7.4. Should a tie result from the total of counting rounds, for any position, the result will be decided by the number of 1st places gained in "A" finals, if still undecided the number of 2nd places in "A" finals, then 3rd places and so on until resolved. Appeals are as per C6.5.1.

1.8. AWARDS.

1.8.1. Per round. There will be a minimum of 1 trophy or goods awarded for every 5 entries in each class. IAME & Honda Cadet will have separate club championship (see 1.7.1) but may be combined in a race. Overall place awards are not given, points are given on class positions. If for any reason the final is cancelled, trophies and points will be awarded on the basis of grid positions. Guest drivers are eligible for trophies.

1.8.2. Overall Championships. Winners of each Championship will receive a Championship trophy and perpetual trophy which may be kept until the last round of the 2017 series. The trophy must be kept in good condition and returned upon request.

1.8.3. An overall championship will only be held if there are ten or more competitors gaining points in the class.

1.8.4. At the club's discretion awards may be given for second and third places overall, if there are sufficient entries.

1.9. COMPETITORS OBLIGATIONS.

1.9.1. It is mandatory for all competitors to attend all drivers briefings arranged by the Clerk of the Course.

1.9.2. Title to awards. In the event of any provisional result or Championship tables being revised after any provisional presentation and such revisions effect the distribution of any awards the competitors concerned must return such awards to Shenington Kart Racing Club in good condition within 7 days. Perpetual SuperPrix trophies must be returned on request.

2. JUDICIAL PROCEDURES. Will be in accordance with the 2016 MSA Yearbook with the exception of C3.5.1 (c) and the specific penalties shown in these regulations.

2.1 ROUNDS & CHAMPIONSHIPS PENALTIES: In accordance with Section C of the current MSA Yearbook and the CIK-FIA Judicial Trial and these regulations and the 2016 Karting Penalty table of mandatory penalties as appended to these regulations.

2.2 By registering for the Championship all competitors, and their associates, commit to the MSA Race 'n' Respect campaign and agree to positively promote and demonstrate the Racing Code.

3. SPORTING REGULATIONS-CHAMPIONSHIP RACE MEETINGS AND RACE PROCEDURE.

3.1. ENTRIES. Supplementary regulations and entry forms will be available to all registered drivers in sufficient time for entries to be made prior to the closing dates.

3.1.1. Competitors are responsible for sending in correct and complete entries with the correct fee to arrive prior to the closing dates, which will be shown in the SRs.

3.1.2. Entries will be acknowledged by email and if a SAE is enclosed with the entry for that purpose.

3.1.3. The entry fee will be according to the SRs for each meeting.

3.1.4. Entry fees will only be refunded in full if withdrawn by written request prior to the closing date.

4. CHAMPIONSHIP AND ROUND PENALTIES.

4.1. INFRINGEMENT OF TECHNICAL REGULATIONS.

4.1.1. Arising from post race scrutineering or Judicial Action, minimum action exclusion from the race or timed qualifying session, the maximum action the provisions of MSA regulations C3.5.1 (a) & (b).

4.1.2. Infringement of non-technical MSA regulations and the Sporting regulations issued herewith and individual SR's, as per 2016 MSA Judicial Procedure Regulations.

5. TECHNICAL REGULATIONS. MSA 2016 Specific karting technical regulations apply together with the 2016 ABkC regulations and ABkC nominated tyres within the 2016 MSA Kart Race Yearbook and the SRs for the meeting.

5.1. ELIGIBLE CLASSES: Provided there is a minimum of ten club members gaining points in the class over the year,(or less at the sole discretion of the club committee), the following classes are offered: IAME Cadet, Honda Cadet, Junior TKM, TKM Extreme (not incl TKM 4-stroke), Mini Max, Junior Max, Senior Max, Max 177, Max 177 Masters, Junior & Senior X30, KZ UK, 250 National & TKM Clubman. The regulations for all classes offered may be found in the 2016 MSA Kart Race Yearbook except X30 KTE-2016-302 is on www.msauk.org website plus these following for the low cost TKM Clubman class (MSA approved under U1.1.3 & U1.2 ref KTE-2016-293):

5.2. As per MSA Kart Race Yearbook C.3.8.4 for TKM Extreme Clubman except for the following:

5.3. Only a 10 tooth front sprocket and a 78 rear sprocket is permitted. If found necessary the club reserves the right to amend the rear sprocket size by bulletin prior to any race meeting.

5.4. No new slick tyres are permitted. Only used slick tyres (to TKM Extreme class regulations) may be used which must be between 2.8mm and 1mm on the tread depth holes at the start of the meeting which will be stamped and must be used at subsequent meetings until below the minimum tread depth. The decision of the Chief Scrutineer on tyre eligibility for a meeting is final. Any request for a change must be made before taking the tyres out of parc ferme on Saturday. Only the wet tyres with labels in just red are permitted unless a bulletin is issued by the club giving one month's notice to use the new wets with red label in white outline.

5.5. The set of approved stamped slick tyres used during each meeting must be returned to the club at the end of each final and will be retained by the club and issued on the next Shenington race weekend. These retained tyres may only be used during practice on Saturday and Sunday race day and must be returned each evening. If not returned a 5 place penalty in the final will be applied at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

5.6. Ride height is not restricted.

5.7. Rev-counters and data loggers are not permitted.

5.8. The winner of a round will be required to add 4kg to the class weight for the following round in which he or she takes part, fixed in accordance with U.29. If not the winner of that subsequent round, the weight penalty may be removed for the next round.

5.9. The 2015 championship winner in the class will have 25 points deducted from his final score in 2016 after dropped scores are applied. A driver who has been awarded a top ten number in the Super One Series anytime within the previous three years may not race in the class, unless with permission from the SKRC committee.

Driver details will be held on a Database and will be subject to the provisions of the Data Protection Act 1998.

The following penalties are as defined on the Clerks Decision Notification and accompanied by the Clerks Decision Notification Explanations issued by MSA. These are mandatory penalties.

Although the above details the mandatory penalties for driving, behaviour etc. this does not preclude the Clerk issuing penalties against other breaches of regulations as defined in (C)2.1.
